THE PROGRAM

It is said that a community is only as strong as those who live there. This is particularly true of community leaders, who help define and implement vision that makes a community great.

- Join a class of 30+ people, representing area businesses, who meet the second Wednesday of each month, September through June, for a 10 month interactive study program.
- Participate in informative sessions with recognized leaders and decision-makers
- Visit businesses and organizations that are impacting our community.
- Explore a wide variety of issues facing our community; each day focuses on a different topic.
- Learn how to apply your skills and interests in solving community issues and expand your business and community network.
- During the duration of the class participants are required to attend one McMinnville School District board meeting, and attend one City Council meeting.

PROGRAM TOPICS

Class members will learn how the community works from the inside out, by listening to a variety of perspectives. Each month, participants hear from community leaders and decision-makers to learn about leadership from people who make things happen. Topics include:

COMMUNITY SERVICE PROJECTS

The Leadership Mac Program places a strong emphasis on volunteerism. The goal is to inspire emerging leaders to participate in the life of the community.

The class chooses one or more hands-on community service projects to participate in during the year. Together, participants plan, strategize and execute their project on behalf of a community cause. In the process, class members learn how to utilize the skills and resources available to them to reach a common goal.

Class members are also encouraged to volunteer individually in a cause of their choice.
