

Financial Assistance Application

McMinnville Area Chamber of Commerce has limited funds available for tuition assistance grants to students in the McMinnville, Amity, Dayton, Sheridan, Willamina and Yamhill/Carlton areas. These funds are to be used toward tuition costs at any accredited college, university, community college, trade or vocational school.

Upon verification of the student's registration as a full-time student, payment will be made jointly to the student and the school. The funds must be applied toward payment of tuition costs for the school year immediately following the date the award is announced. Awards offered, but not verified by December 31 of the year during which the award was granted, will be withdrawn.

Qualifications for tuition assistance will be determined by the Chamber's Scholarship Selection Committee according to the financial need, personal character, service-mindedness, academic record and the sincere interest of the student to pursue further education. Decisions of the selection committee are final.

The Chamber's tuition assistance grant is not intended to finance the student's entire program, however may help reduce dependence upon part-time work or student borrowing.

Careful and detailed completion of this application form is important. Answers to questions, or any other information furnished by the student in this application, or in any subsequent interview by the selection committee will be held in strict confidence by the Chamber.

This application must be returned to your high school counseling office on or before Friday, April 11, 2025.
